Agenda was sent via email. Two corrections were made and approved.

Chief of Police: Keith Meadows

- Department has made significant progress:
 - Violent crimes cut in half
 - Offer security for 108,000 homes in COF
 - Lot of gang related activity; District 1 & 2, a lot of juvenile crime; decreased a lot this year.
 - Lot of crime on Fulton Industrial COF patrolled only half year.
 - o Average three murders per year
 - o Increase in traffic fatalities (38 to-date). They doubled in every city.
 - Average about \$5,000 per month from speeding in school zone.
- Going to start a public safety campaign for Police, Fire and Public Works. Should roll out early next year. Purchased 9 acres of land on Old National near St. James Street. Plan to build a Police Safety Facility, with a walking trail, internet exchanges, etc. Greatest percent of crime takes place on Old National.
- Cry Wolf Program: 11,000 false alarms per year.

- Thank you to Beautification Committee for decorations at entrances.
